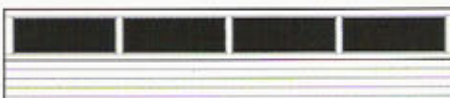

- Concealed steel plates run continuously from top to bottom of each section for fastening hardware

TRACKS

- Tracks are 2" or 3", as specified

HARDWARE

- Package includes 14-gauge or 11-gauge hinges, as specified

RESIDENTIAL/COMMERCIAL LIMITED WARRANTY

SECTIONS

- C.H.I. warrants the material and workmanship of the sections against defects in material and workmanship for the following time periods from the date of installation, whichever is longer:
 - Residential applications are warranted for as long as the original purchaser/owner resides in the building that the door was installed for (up to a maximum of 10 years).
 - Model 3200 and Model 3201 are warranted for 10 years.
 - Series 3300 and 3300 series bronze doors are covered for three (3) years. Field painting of series 3300 and 3300 doors with clear urethane finish does not void this warranty.
 - Series 3400 wood-grain finish doors are covered for one (1) year.
 - Finishing of series 3400 wood-grain finish doors is an inherent characteristic and is not considered a defect.
 - Series 3400 Series must be field painted according to C.H.I. painting instructions prior to installation.
- Commercial applications are covered for ten (10) years.

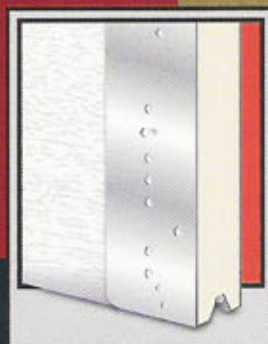
GENERAL COMMENTS

- C.H.I. warrants all hardware against spring failure.
- Residential 4:1 spring low headroom is warranted for three (3) years.
- Residential 18 gauge galvanized and bronze finish doors are warranted for ten (10) years.
- Model 3200, Model 3201 and Commercial door hardware is warranted for ten (10) years.

SPRINGS

- C.H.I. warrants springs to be installed according to the following:
 - Three (3) years on doors up to eight (8) feet and one (1) door for Model 3200 and Model 3201.
 - One (1) year for doors over eight (8) feet high.
- C.H.I. warrants springs for use in proper wall clearance applications.

All warranty periods begin from date of installation.
In the event the door is damaged, a claim for repair must be submitted to C.H.I. Domestic Office, 100 West 29th Street, St. Louis, MO 63103. Such claims must be made within three (3) days of the discovery of the reported defect.
After installation, C.H.I. shall not be permitted to repair the door unless an authorized C.H.I. representative has been notified in writing of the defect within 30 days of the date of installation. The contractor shall be responsible for the repair of the door.
This limited warranty applies only to the door and excludes: (1) all damage by improper installation or operation of the door; (2) damage resulting from improper use or misuse of the door; (3) damage to the door or its components resulting from improper use, neglect, or other causes; (4) damage to the door or its components resulting from fire, flood, or other causes; (5) damage to the door or its components resulting from contact with other objects; (6) damage to the door or its components resulting from contact with other objects; (7) damage to the door or its components resulting from contact with other objects; (8) damage to the door or its components resulting from contact with other objects.
